- SacBAC suggestions for on/off-ramp treatment:
 - Signage for pedestrians and bicyclists (peds and cyclists HERE) - consider bikes to share sidewalk, walk bike across overpass
 - Zebra crosswalk (high visibility)
 - Green hash (weaving) striping across ramps
- Caltrans will dictate treatment across the freeway on-ramps
- Green bike lane policy needs to be created – volume as a reason, across free rights turns at Stockton at Florin Rd
 - 3-1 look at Stockton at Florin approaches for weaving treatment/ high conflict area. Wursten, Koumis, Cassera vs Schooley
